2. After logging in, you'll either see the District Dashboard (if you are a district administrator) or the School Dashboard (if you are a school administrator). If you are looking at the School Dashboard, then you're already in the right place! If you see the District Dashboard, simply tap or click on the name of any school in your list to view that school's dashboard.
3. On the left side of the school dashboard, tap or click the Key Metrics Dashboard link. If your school uses the ENIL, you'll actually see two links. One for the IRLA, and the other for the ENIL.
